Election Date: November 8 **Deadline to Register to Vote:**

> Online or In Person: October 10

By Mail: October 31

VOTING BY MAIL

Voting in Washington is done by mail. If you are registered at your current address by October 10, you will automatically receive an official ballot as early as October 21.

DEADLINE TO SUBMIT YOUR COMPLETED BALLOT BY MAIL

Must be postmarked by November 8

VOTING IN PERSON ON ELECTION DAY

If you prefer, you may also vote in person at a voting center.

Remember to Bring: ID required. Voters without ID will be issued a provisional ballot.
